**The House of Representatives Chamber**

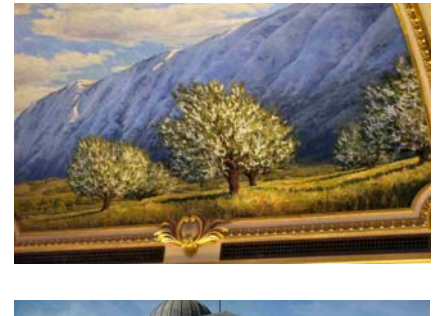
In addition to exceptional technology, the Chamber for Utah's 75 Representatives features restored decorative trim and wall surfaces, replications of the original furnishings and light fixtures, and two new murals by Utah artist David Koch. The north mural shows Seraph Young voting in the municipal election of 1869; the south is the Engen Brothers building the Ecker Hill ski jump. Both events changed the destiny of the state. *The Dream of Brigham Young and The Discovery of the Great Salt Lake* are by New York artists Forringer and Aderente.

**The Supreme Court Chamber**

The Utah Supreme Court now convenes in the Matheson Courthouse. Originally, however, the five-member court met regularly in this ornate chamber. The rich, gilded ornamental trim, symbolic cartouches, and color scheme are typical of the classical revival style Kletting used in his winning designs of the 1916 Capitol. The painting of *Caroline Bridge* by H. L. A. Culmer was a gift to the Capitol Commission from Edwin Holmes, one of Salt Lake City's leading citizens at the turn of the 20th century.
