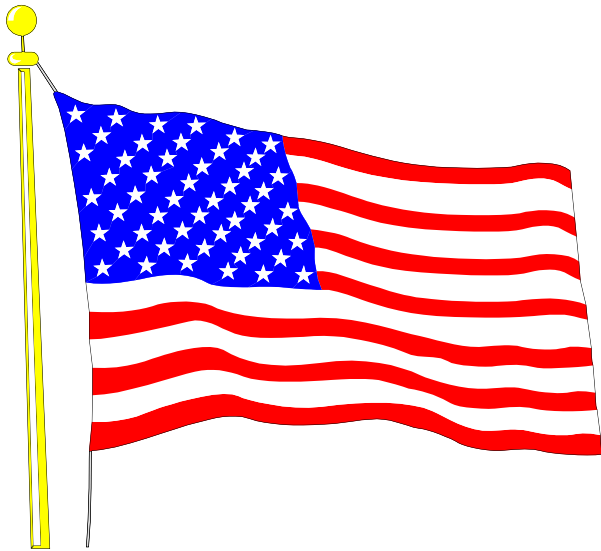

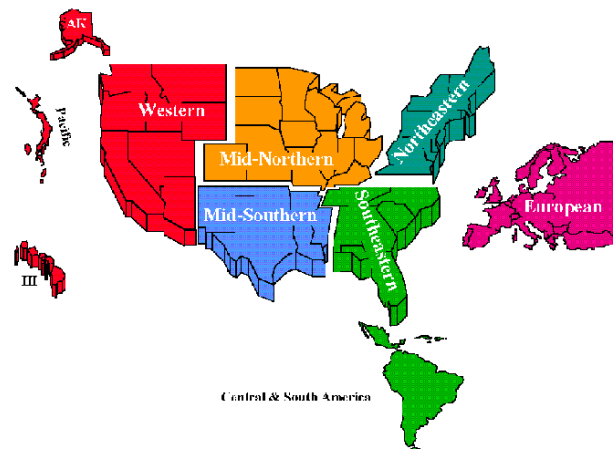
## USAWOA Corporate Membership Program
