Our membership may or may not know that last year the BOD approved a new award to be given to outstanding members. Here are the levels and criteria for each:

The Honorable Order of the Eagle Rising	Any Region, Chapter or Auxiliary for the awards year May be nominated by any National, Region or Chapter Awards Committee Note: National elected and appointed officers are not eligible for this award while they are serving. **Gold: Contribution to Division or higher, WO Corps Army-wide, USAWOA regional or national, civic in multiple counties.

Silver: Contribution to Battalion to Brigade, WO Corps in area, USAWOA in region, civic in county or large city.

Bronze: Brigade or below, WO at post, USAWOA Chapter, civic in local area.

The cost of the award is a mere \$25.00, a small price for such large recognition!

Please take the time to nominate those chapter members who went above and beyond supporting not only the Chapters but the communities as well.
