1. EXPIRATION:

- A. THIS MESSAGE IS EFFECTIVE UPON RELEASE AND WILL EXPIRE NLT 31 DECEMBER 2011.
- B. THIS MESSAGE RESINDS MILPER MESSAGE NUMBER 09-303 DATED 30 DEC 09.

2. THE PURPOSE OF THIS MESSAGE IS TO PROVIDE UPDATED POLICY AND IMPLEMENTATION GUIDANCE FOR A CALL TO ACTIVE DUTY (CAD) REGULAR ARMY AVAILABLE TO SELECTED RESERVE COMPONENT (RC) OFFICERS. SPECIAL BRANCHES (CH, JA, AND AMEDD) ARE NOT ELIGIBLE UNDER THIS PROGRAM.

3. THERE ARE SEVERAL MAJOR CHANGES TO THE CALL TO ACTIVE DUTY (REGULAR ARMY) PROGRAM THAT ARE SUMMARIZED HERE (SEE PARA 5 FOR DETAILS):

- A. THIS PROGRAM IS CLOSED TO LTs.
- B. THIS PROGRAM IS CLOSED TO LTCs.

C. THIS PROGRAM IS OPEN TO CPTs IN A LIMITED NUMBER OF BASIC BRANCHES AND FUNCTIONAL AREAS LISTED IN PARAGRAPH 5A.

D. THIS PROGRAM REMAINS OPEN FOR ALL BASIC BRANCH AND FUNCTIONAL AREA MAJs.

E. APPLICATIONS MAILED TO HRC PRIOR TO THE RELEASE OF THIS MESSAGE UNDER THE PROVISIONS OF MILPER MESSAGE NUMBER 09-303 DATED 30 DEC 09 WILL BE PROCESSED.

F. THOUGH NOT DIRECTLY DISCUSSED IN RECENT CALL TO ACTIVE DUTY PROGRAM MILPER MESSAGES, THIS PROGRAM REMAINS OPEN TO RC CW2 – CW4 WARRANT OFFICERS IN ANY OF THE BASIC BRANCH MOS'. APPLICATION PROCEDURES AND ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA ARE AS DISCUSSED BELOW.

4. DUE TO THE BASE REALIGNMENT AND CLOSURE (BRAC), THE ARMY HUMAN RESOURCES COMMAND, ALEXANDRIA, VA, WILL NO LONGER BE ABLE TO ACCEPT MAILED CAD APPLICATIONS AFTER 01 AUGUST 2010. NOT EARLIER THAN 31 OCTOBER 2010, ALL APPLICATIONS SHOULD BE MAILED TO:

5. ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS ARE FOUND IN AR 135-210, AND INCLUDE THE FOLLOWING CRITERIA:

A: FOR CPTS ONLY, THIS PROGRAM IS OPEN FOR FUNCTIONAL AREAS 53 (INFORMATION SYSTEMS MANAGEMENT) AND 57 (SIMULATION OPERATIONS) AND BASIC BRANCHES AC, AG, CM, FI, LOG, MI, AND SC. THIS PROGRAM IS CLOSED TO CPTSs IN ALL OTHER FUNCTIONAL AREAS AND BASIC BRANCHES.

B. DATE OF RANK MUST BE:

(1) CPT: 20070118 OR AFTER.

(2) MAJ: 20060930 OR AFTER

C. MUST BE A GRADUATE OF:

(1) FOR CPTS: AN ACC BASIC BRANCH BASIC OFFICER LEADERSHIP COURSE (BOLC) III OR B.

(2) FOR MAJORS: AN ACC CAPTAIN CAREER COURSE (CCC)

D. MUST HAVE SERVED AT LEAST FOUR YEARS ACTIVE FEDERAL COMMISSIONED SERVICE (AFCS).

E. MUST BE MEDICALLY QUALIFIED IAW AR 40-501 (STANDARDS OF MEDICAL FITNESS) CHAPTER 3.

F. APPLICATIONS FOR ANY BRANCH TRANSFERS MUST BE ACCOMPANIED WITH JUSTIFICATION/QUALIFICATIONS.

G. MUST BE BRANCH QUALIFIED AS A CPT IN SF, CA, or PO TO APPLY FOR UTILIZATION IN THOSE BRANCHES (FOR MAJs ONLY).

H. MUST HAVE A SECURITY CLEARANCE OF SECRET OR HIGHER. APPLICANTS FOR MILITARY INTELLIGENCE MUST HAVE ONE OF THE FOLLOWING: A SPECIAL BACKGROUND INVESTIGATION, SINGLE SCOPE BACKGROUND INVESTIGATION (SBI/SSBI), OR A PERIODIC REINVESTIGATION WITHIN THE LAST FIVE YEARS AND BE ELIGIBLE FOR A TOP SECRET CLEARANCE WITH SCI ACCESS PRIOR TO MAKING APPLICATION FOR THIS PROGRAM.

I. MUST HAVE BACCALAUREATE DEGREE.

J. MUST MEET HEIGHT & WEIGHT STANDARDS AS OUTLINED IN AR 600-9.

K. MUST BE ABLE TO ATTAIN 20 YEARS ACTIVE FEDERAL COMMISSIONED SERVICE (AFCS) BY AGE 62.

L. MUST BE ABLE TO COMPLETE 10 YEARS OF ACTIVE COMMISSIONED SERVICE (ACS) BEFORE COMPLETING 20 YEARS ACTIVE FEDERAL SERVICE (AFS).

M. ALL APPLICANTS MUST BE CITIZENS OF THE UNITED STATES.

6. INELIGIBILITY CRITERIA:

A. ALL LTs AND LTCs.

B. ALL CPTS IN FUNCTIONAL AREAS 24, 30, 34, 40, 46, 48, 49, 50, 52, AND 59 AND IN BASIC BRANCHES AD, AR, AV, CA, EN, FA, IN, MP, PO, AND SF.

C. OFFICERS WHO HAVE BEEN NON-SELECTED FOR PROMOTION TO THE NEXT HIGHER GRADE.

D. IN THE ZONE OF CONSIDERATION FOR A RESERVE COMPONENT PROMOTION BOARD CONVENING WITHIN SIX MONTHS OF THE APPLICATION'S RECEIPT BY HRC.

E. CURRENTLY ACTIVATED/MOBILIZED. APPLICATIONS MAY BE FORWARDED PROVIDED EARLY RELEASE FROM MOBILIZATION IS AUTHORIZED BY THE ACTIVE ARMY COMMANDER (COL OR ABOVE). OFFICERS AUTHORIZED EARLY RELEASE MUST INCLUDE THE APPROVAL CORRESPONDENCE.

F. CURRENTLY ON ACTIVE DUTY FOR OPERATION SUPPORT (ADOS), UNLESS WITHIN SIX MONTHS OF EXPIRATION OF ADOS, OR EARLY RELEASE IS AUTHORIZED BY THE ACTIVE ARMY COMMANDER (COL OR ABOVE). OFFICERS AUTHORIZED EARLY RELEASE MUST INCLUDE THE APPROVAL CORRESPONDENCE.

G. CURRENTLY ON ARNG ACTIVE GUARD RESERVE (AGR) DUTY, UNLESS RELEASE IS AUTHORIZED BY THE ARADMD/AGR MANAGER. AGR OFFICERS AUTHORIZED RELEASE MUST INCLUDE THE APPROVAL CORRESPONDENCE.

H. RELEASED FROM AD FOR ANY OF THE FOLLOWING REASONS:

- (1) AS A RESULT OF AN ACTIVE DUTY SHOW CAUSE BOARD.
- (2) AS A RESULT OF MEDICAL BOARD PROCEEDINGS.
- (3) FOR HARDSHIP OR COMPASSIONATE REASONS, UNLESS DOCUMENTED EVIDENCE IS

PROVIDED THAT VERIFIES THE REASON(S) FOR SEPARATION HAS BEEN RESOLVED.
(4) RESIGNATION IN LIEU OF ELIMINATION OR RESIGNATION FOR THE GOOD OF THE SERVICE IN LIEU OF COURT-MARTIAL.
(5) RECEIVED VOLUNTARY SEPARATION INCENTIVE OR ANY TYPE OF SEPARATION PAYMENT, THIS CAN BE WAIVED: HOWEVER, RECOUPMENT OCCURS UPON RECEIPT OF RETIRED PAY.

7. APPLICATION PROCEDURES:

A. EACH APPLICANT WILL SUBMIT THE FOLLOWING DOCUMENTS:

- (1) IF A MEMBER OF THE ARMY NATIONAL GUARD, MUST HAVE AN APPROVED CONDITIONAL RELEASE, EITHER BY MEMORANDUM OR DD FORM 368, FROM THE STATE ADJUTANT GENERAL/REGIONAL READINESS COMMAND (RRC) COMMANDING GENERAL, OR HIS/HER DESIGNATED REPRESENTATIVE.
- (2) CHAIN OF COMMAND ENDORSEMENTS (EXCEPT IRR/IMA) THROUGH THE STATE ADJUTANT GENERAL/REGIONAL READINESS COMMAND (RRC) COMMANDING GENERAL, OR HIS/HER DESIGNATED REPRESENTATIVE.
- (3) APPLICATIONS FROM USAR AND ARNG ACTIVE/GUARD RESERVE OFFICERS (AGR) (USC TITLE 10 & 32) MUST INCLUDE CONCURRENCE FROM THEIR RESPECTIVE CAREER AGR MANAGER.
- (4) DA FORM 160-R, APPLICATION FOR ACTIVE DUTY.
- (5) ALL APPLICANTS, OTHER THAN AVIATION, ARE REQUIRED TO HAVE A CURRENT CHAPTER 3, AR 40-501 PHYSICAL OR VALID MEDPROS STATEMENT. APPLICANTS ARE AUTHORIZED A MEDICAL EXAMINATION AS OUTLINED UNDER AR 40-501, CHAPTER 3 AND DOD 6130.3, IF LAST EXAMINATION IS MORE THAN 5 YEARS FROM DATE OF APPLICATION.
- (6) AVIATION BRANCH APPLICANTS MUST HAVE AN APPROVED CLASS II FLIGHT PHYSICAL WITHIN 12 MONTHS OR A CURRENT PENDING FLIGHT PHYSICAL WITH A CURRENT UP SLIP.
- (7) APPLICANTS MUST PROVIDE VERIFICATION THAT A NON-REACTIVE HIV TEST HAS BEEN TAKEN WITHIN THE TWO YEARS PRIOR TO THE START DATE OF ACTIVE DUTY. TEST MUST BE ADMINISTERED BY A MILITARY INSTALLATION OR DOD CONTRACTOR.
- (8) STATEMENT OF SECURITY CLEARANCE FROM A SECURITY MANAGER STATING CLEARANCE LEVEL, DATE FINAL CLEARANCE GRANTED, TYPE OF INVESTIGATION CONDUCTED, AND DATE BACKGROUND INVESTIGATION COMPLETED OR CONFIRMATION OF CLEARANCE INITIATION OR COMPLETED NAC/DNACJ. THIS STATEMENT IS SEPARATE FROM THE SF 86.
- (9) IF THE DATE THE CLEARANCE WAS GRANTED IS MORE THAN 9 YEARS AGO FOR SECRET, (4 YEARS FOR TOP SECRET), THEN AN ELECTRONIC SF 86 (QUESTIONNAIRE FOR NATIONAL SECURITY POSITIONS) MUST BE SUBMITTED. SUBMIT HARDCOPY SF86 WITH THE SIGNED AUTHORIZATION FORMS FOR MEDICAL AND PERSONNEL INFORMATION, THE DEFENSE SECURITY SERVICE (DSS) HAS MANDATED THE USE OF THE ELECTRONIC PERSONNEL SECURITY QUESTIONNAIRE (EPSQ). (3) REPORT DATE AND ASSIGNMENT LOCATION FOR OFFICERS SELECTED FOR AD WILL BE DETERMINED BY THE APPROPRIATE CAREER DIVISION, PROMOTION CONSIDERATION WILL BE IAW THE CURRENT REGULAR ARMY ACC COMMISSIONED OFFICER PROMOTION SYSTEM.

(4) OFFICERS APPLYING FOR ACTIVE DUTY THROUGH THE CAD PROGRAM WILL HAVE TO BE APPROVED FOR REGULAR ARMY APPOINTMENT PRIOR TO COMING INTO THE REGULAR ARMY. THIS PROCESS INCLUDES THE SUBMISSION OF THE OFFICER'S NAMES ON A SCROLL FOR APPROVAL BY THE SECRETARY OF DEFENSE FOR COMPANY GRADE OFFICERS AND THE SENATE FOR FIELD GRADE OFFICERS. SCROLL APPROVAL COULD TAKE ON AVERAGE 30-45 DAYS FOR COMPANY GRADE OFFICERS AND 4 MONTHS FOR FIELD GRADE OFFICERS.

(5) SELECTED OFFICERS APPROVED FOR THE CALL TO ACTIVE DUTY PROGRAM WILL INCUR A THREE YEAR ACTIVE DUTY SERVICE OBLIGATION (ADSO).

(6) TO BE ELIGIBLE FOR PROMOTION CONSIDERATION UPON RETURN TO REGULAR ARMY (AD), SELECTED OFFICERS MUST COMPLETE AT LEAST ONE YEAR OF CONTINUOUS ACTIVE DUTY AS OF THE CONVENE DATE OF THE PROMOTION BOARD IN WHICH THEIR ACTIVE DATE OF RANK (ADOR) PLACES THEM IN THE ZONE OF CONSIDERATION.

(7) REQUEST FOR WAIVERS OF ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA NOT SPECIFICALLY AUTHORIZED BY THIS MESSAGE WILL NOT BE CONSIDERED.
